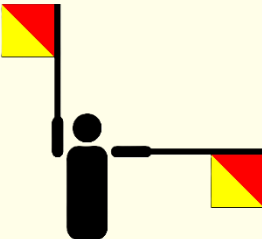
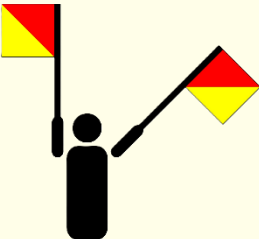
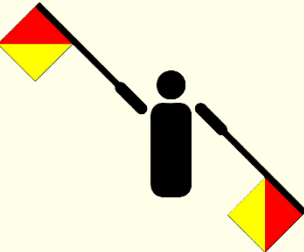
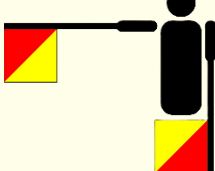
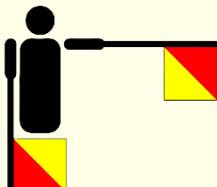
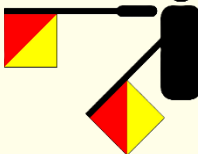
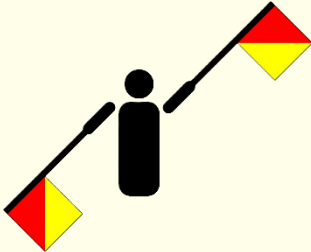
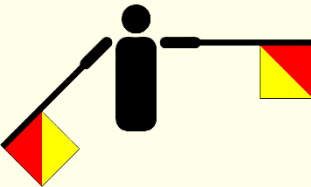
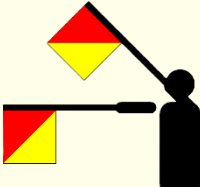
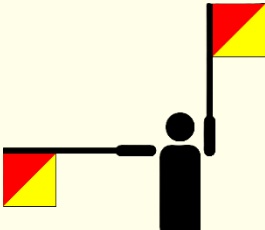
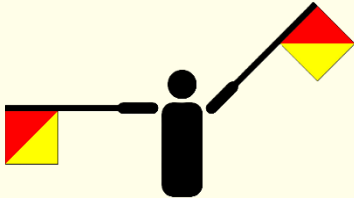
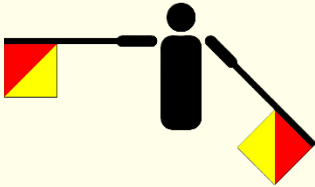
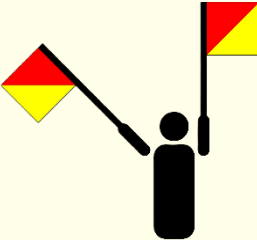


Semaphore signal flags using the "Able Baker" Joint Army/Navy Phonetic Alphabet, adopted in 1941

- ... Use the ATTENTION signal to request permission to begin transmitting, then the READY signal to begin, then indicate whether the signal will be ALPHABETICAL (using the signal J “JIG”) or NUMERICAL.
- ... Signals A through K (excluding “J”) can also indicate numerals 1 through 0, depending on whether the ALPHABETICAL or the NUMERICAL signal is given first.
